PUBLIC NOTICE

To facilitate stakeholders, educational institutes/examination bodies & recruitment agencies the Central Teacher Eligibility Test Unit of Central Board of Secondary Education has introduced an online verification system for CTET eligibility certificates issued after February 2015. Each certificate issued by CTET Unit has been uniquely identified with a Global Document Type Identifier (GDTI) which is encoded in a GS1 QR Code. The GS1 QR Code is printed on the top-right corner of the certificate and when the QR Code is scanned by any QR code scanner mobile application the information associated with the certificate i.e. full name, photograph, roll number, date of issue, marks obtained etc. stored in CBSE secured server will be displayed on the mobile of verifying agency.

Hence, it is to inform all the educational institutes/examination bodies & recruitment agencies that the existing system of verification of certificates of CTET issued after February 2015 is hereby discontinued and request for manual verification of CTET certificates issued before February 2015 only will be considered by CTET Unit of Central Board of Secondary Education.

The steps for verification of certificate embedded with GS1 QR Code through mobile application are as under:

- Step 1.** Download any QR Code Scanner application in mobile.
- Step 2.** Scan the QR Code printed at top right corner of the certificate.
- Step 3.** Click on the link generated after scan of QR Code.
- Step 4.** Verify the credentials of certificate with information shown on mobile.
